The workshop will include painting in Monet's Garden, the village, other gardens, and some journeys to other locations for added inspiration. The workshop begins with your arrival on Wednesday, June 4th, 2015 and ends with departure on Wednesday, June 11th, 2015. Open to artists of all mediums.

Pat will be instructing in Oil and Watercolor.
