

## Plein Air Painting Workshop Supply Checklist

### For Watercolor:

- Paper: blocks or loose sheets plus plexi-board/tape/clips
- Paints (minimal palette is fine) or you can use watercolor pencils for sketching
- Brushes-flat, round, rigger, hake- a couple of different sizes
- Palette
- Tissues or Paper towels
- Cup for water
- Spray bottle
- Container with cap to carry water
- #2 Pencil, eraser, sharpener
- Sketch book
- Scrap paper for testing colors
- Markers for value sketches, red acetate for values
- Masking tape
- Credit card or palette knife for scraping
- Small folding chair/stool or Portable easel
- Plastic bag for trash

### For Oil Painting:

- Brushes
- Paint
- Palette
- Easel
- Solvents, cup to hold solvent
- Brush cleaner, baby wipes for cleaning hands
- Panels
- Wet panel carrier
- Saran wrap
- Paper towels
- Plastic bag for garbage

### General:

- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Water/snack
- Hat/visor

Camera (and back up battery)
